This year, Rock Port High School is sending six students to the state contest on Friday, April 27, at the University of Missouri in Columbia.

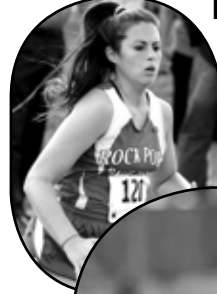

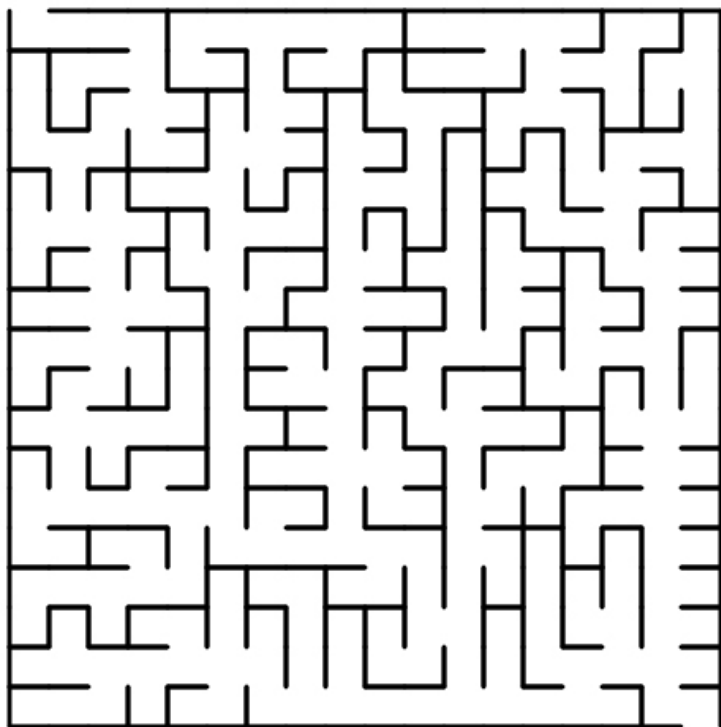
