



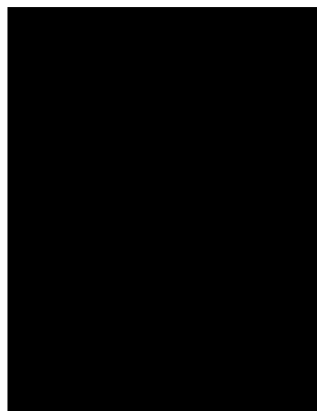
# BLUE JAY CORNER
